# PRUNUS

### Well-branching, strong growth

There are different types of evergreen Prunus, which are quite well-liked as hedge plants. The good health, strong growth and compact habitus are major advantages. Besides that, the different cultivars are resistant to extreme cold. If they are not pruned, they will really blossom in the spring.



## TAXUS

### Healthy, shapeable, hardy

Taxus has been a well-liked shape plant for centuries. Hedges, squares, bowls, and fantasy shapes are possible. A major advantage is that the plant can be pruned to the bare wood, Taxus always sprouts. Besides the evergreen quality, being hardy is also a great advantage.



### PICEA

#### Gracious, solitary, narrow habitus

Picea, the fir, grows in the entire northern hemisphere. The closer to the North Pole, the slower the trees grow and the better the quality of the pine. P. omorika, the Serbian fir, is a narrow, upright grower with hanging branches. This type is among the most elegant firs.
